Rosemarie Ochoa is a native of Little Rock and began her organ studies at Hendrix College in August 2017. She graduated *magna cum laude* from Hendrix with a Bachelor of Arts in Music and Spanish. Rosemarie has served as the Assistant Organist at the Cathedral of Saint Andrew in Little Rock since September 2021. Her organ teacher is Beau Baldwin.



Chandler Freligh is a young organist from Forrest City, Arkansas where he plays the organ for Good Shepherd Episcopal Church and plays at Wynne Baptist Church in the youth band on Wednesday nights. Chandler began organ lessons in June of this year after studying the piano for 11 years. Currently a senior at Wynne High School, he plans to attend Arkansas State University in Jonesboro where he will major in music education. As a member of the band at Wynne Senior High, Chandler is currently Section Leader and First Chair in the trumpet section and has served as First Tenor Section Leader in the school's choir. Chandler has also participated in the Arkansas Interfaith Conference Choir Camp. Aside from studying organ, piano, and voice, Chandler has a lifelong affinity for theatre, and has participated in numerous theatrical productions in the community. He currently studies organ with Alex Turner.



Daniel Gauger is a native of Little Rock, Arkansas and a graduate of Little Rock Central High School. He is currently in his senior year at the University of Oklahoma studying organ performance under the instruction of Dr. Adam Pajan and Dr. Damin Spritzer. Before attending the University of Oklahoma, Gauger was an organ student of Jim Maase (starting in 2017) and Bob Bidewell (2014). Since August of 2022, Gauger has served as Organist at St. James the Greater Catholic Church in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma
